This is the newsletter for Project "Hästen 21", located at the intersection of Regeringsgatan and Mäster Samuelsgatan.



About Project Hästen 21

With the new development, Pembroke creates a modern and sustainable building with office, retail and residential spaces. The new Hästen 21 will open up the neighborhood and with



new passages, restaurants and stores we transform one of Stockholm's most central districts into a more accessible and attractive place, 24/7.

The city development project started in August 2022 and the new building is planned to deliver in 2026. It will feature a light natural stone and glass façade, green rooftops and terraces. The architecture is inspired by the existing buildings in the area and the size and height of the Hästen 21 building have been carefully designed to blend in with the cityscape.
